## ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP AND PROCEDURES

1. The Finance Committee shall submit a Proposed Budget annually, first, to the Executive Board and then for adoption by a majority of the membership present at a regular scheduled meeting.
2. The Finance Committee shall budget adequate funds for chapter
expenses.
